## WHAT TO BRING:

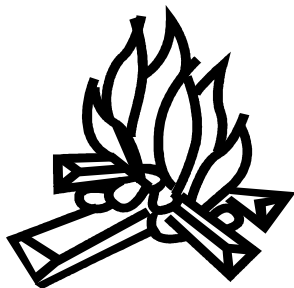
